### **Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)**

#### **What is LIHEAP?**

LIHEAP is a federal program that provides assistance to eligible low-income households to manage and meet their immediate home heating and/or cooling needs.

#### **What kind of assistance does LIHEAP offer?**

LIHEAP offers several kinds of services to help low-income households meet their home energy needs. These services include:

- The **Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)** provides one-time financial assistance to help offset an eligible households energy costs (utility bill).
- The **Energy Crisis Intervention Program** provides assistance to low-income households that are in a crisis situation. Examples include a household that has received a 24- to 48-hour disconnect notice or service termination by its utility company or a household facing an energy-related crisis or life-threatening emergency of the applicants household, including a combustible appliance.
- Another service offered as a component to other LIHEAP services includes energy budget counseling on basic energy efficiency.

#### **Can this program help you?**

Answer the following questions to see if LIHEAP may be able to help you:

- Have you received a 24– to 48– hour disconnect notice or service termination from your utility company?
- Do you need financial assistance paying your utility bill?
- Do you think home energy efficiency upgrades would help lower your monthly utility bill?

If you answered “yes” to any of these questions, you may benefit from LIHEAP services.

## ANNOUNCEMENTS

### APS Billings

If you need assistance, **PLEASE**, bring in your electric bill **BEFORE** it is shut off. It is difficult to assist when you bring in the billing the day of the shut-off notice.

#### **You must bring in the following to be assisted:**

- APS Bill — your name must be on the bill.
- Check Stub — your check stub is needed if you are employed.
- Number of people in the household.

#### **Office Hours:**

I will be in my office **Tuesdays from 8:00am—12:00pm** to take your bills and for you to fill your applications for assistance.

#### **Sales Tax Applications:**

East, West, and North Cocopah Reservation is Federal Land and exempt from the Arizona State Sales taxes. The forms are here at the office, and you can fill it out and drop it off at the APS off, or you may drop it off at the Nutrition Center.

### Energy Saving Tips
