
Agave plants are special since they are a long-lived plant (20-25 years) that flower only once.

The appearance of the large and tall flower stalk signals the end of the agave plant. The formation of the flower blossoms on the top of the stalk depletes the carbohydrate stockpile in the leaves and roots.

Desert Bats visit the flowers and spread agave pollen.

Under the Cocopah Law and Order Code, a Tribal Advocate must:

- a. Member of a federally recognized Indian Tribe;
- b. Submit an application to the Cocopah Court. If currently or previously admitted as an advocate in any other
- jurisdiction, submit proof of good standing from each jurisdiction;
- d. Never have ever been convicted of a felony:
- e. Not have been convicted of a misdemeanor within the past seven (7) years; and
- f. Earn a passing score on the Cocopah Bar Examination.

If you meet the requirements listed above, and would like to help your community, please contact the Cocopah Tribal court at (928) 627-2550.

The turnout of children at this event was around 200 kids with 164 dozen eggs to find. There were 6 lucky egg winners for the three age categories which were ages 1 to 4 years old, ages 5 to 8 year olds, and 9 to 12 year olds. The winners received a big toy/candy baskets for finding the lucky eggs. The children were entertained by two inflatable character jumpers for them to jump around in, face painting and balloon sculpturing, soda drinking contest for all, musical basket games, and egg toss for all ages. Prizes were given out to the top two winners for each of the games. Candy bags were distributed out to all the kids at this Easter event. 
